- Approved by IPC Swimming and results will be included into the world ranking
- Opportunity to achieve MSQ for EC Dublin 2018

## A. General information

### 1. Organiser:

SK KONTAKT PRAHA in cooperation with KONTAKT bB, sanctioned by Czech Sports Organization for Physically Disabled with Czech Paralympic Committee endorsement.

### 2. Date and venue:

Saturday, November 25, 2017 - [Aquacentrum Šutka - Čimická 848/41 182 00 Praha 8](#)

Competition pool: indoor 50m, minimal depth 1,35m, 8 lanes, water temperature 27°, Omega electronic timing, Wave killer ropes.

Warm up/down: it is possible to use the top aquapark part for warm down in leisure pool, water temperature 29°, see <https://www.sutka.eu/gallery/detail/43>

### 3. Entries:

- The closing date for entries is **11. 11. at 11:00**. Use the entry excel form please. Later entries may not be accepted.
- The Organiser will issue the invoice in according to the number of entered persons relating to the date 11. 11. 2017. After this date is entry fee non-refundable, but teams can substitute team member by another.
- All changes must be reported by e-mail [skkp@sk-kp.cz](mailto:skkp@sk-kp.cz).
- Start list will be issued at 23. 11. 2017 at 11:00. After this date will be not possible to make any changes except complete deregistration of the swimmer/staff. Start list will not be rescheduled.

### 4. Entry fee:

There are two options – **1. Entry pack Mini – 30€ per team member** includes just the competition (participation, gift bag with t-shirt, packed lunch on Saturday during the competition, drinking water at the pool); all transport, accommodation, training is up to the team.

**2. Entry pack Maxi – 100€ per day per team member** includes all the service with transport, accommodation, regular trainings twice in a day and invitation for the ceremonial evening on Saturday. Entry fee (both Mini and Maxi pack as well) for persons withdrawn after November 11 will be not refunded, you can do the substitution in the team with another person.

### 5. Accommodation and transport:

If you choose Entry pack Mini, accommodation and transport is up to you. If you choose Entry pack Maxi (100€/day/team member), we arrange for you the accommodation in 4 stars hotel with full board ([Hotel Troja](#)), transport from/to the airport, transport between pool and hotel during the training days and during competition, entry to the pool twice a day in competition pool (there are lanes and it is possible to train there smoothly).

### 6. Accreditation:

After the arrival due to the arrangement with LOC, at least on Saturday, November 25, 2017 from 9:00 to 10:00 hrs. at the Sport Information Desk (SID) at the pool.

## **B. Technical information**

### **1. Rules:**

Competition will be run under appropriate parts of World Para Swimming Rules and Regulations (February 2015), in accordance with these Entry Information and appropriate national rules and regulations for the Czech Cup in Swimming 2017. Competition is open for classes S1 – S14.

### **2. Competition system**

Competition will take place in one (1) day and will be split into two (2) sessions. There will be heats only, no finals. All classes will be seeded into the heats in accordance with entered times, male and female separately. There will be multi-disability ranking by point score system of KONTAKT bB (point score system of German Paralympic Swimming is being used) according to the relevant class, all age groups together, male and female separately. Swimmers on first three (3) places will get medal and diploma. There will be no victory ceremony for individual events, medals and diplomas will be delivered to the team leader or to the pigeon boxes. The results of individual events will be sent to WPS to be entered to the world rankings for swimmers with IPC SDMS registration.

#### **Relays**

The relays will be seeded according to entered times. The relays will be held in accordance with the Czech Cup rules and relays results will not be the part of the results sent to WPS. Relays can be composed anyhow (any mix male and female with no age limitation). There will be no medals and victory ceremony for relays. The Organiser keeps the right to restrict the number of relays per team or in the case of time deficiency to cancel the relays. Relays must be entered always at least one hour prior to the commencement of each competition block.

### **3. Classification**

Proper classification (international or national) is required for participation at this competition. If your swimmers have no classification, you can enter them into the classification – this is just the national one, your swimmer will obtain the class valid as the national classification. It is not official international classification but it can give you the basic idea - the head of classification is Jana Svarcova, for many years the international classifier of WPS level 2. The classification will be held on Friday November 24, 2017 – schedule will be announced according to the number of swimmers entered for classification. The classification fee is 90€. The Organiser reserves the right to limit the number of swimmers for classification.

### **4. Protests:**

In accordance with WPS Rules 2.10 basically, means that protest must be submitted by team leader only to the referee on the WPS protest form in written within 30 minutes following the publication of the official results together with deposit of 20€. In case of rejection of the protest, the deposit keeps with the Organiser.

### **5. Restrictions:**

The Organiser keeps the right to limit number of entered swimmers to adhere the time schedule. All participants will be allowed to the pool after changing shoes and clothing. Wheels of wheelchairs need to be covered with special covers (available at pool reception).
